The \$750 Michael & Lucy Steiner Study Abroad Scholarship is offered each year to an American Studies major, minor, or graduate student at Cal State Fullerton, to help offset the costs of CSUF Study Abroad, Study Away, or other CSUF travel and scholarship programs. To be eligible, you must have earned at least 9 units in American Studies and be accepted into a CSUF travel and study program. Criteria for the Steiner Scholarship includes financial need, scholarship, and your own statement of purpose.

Applications are due March 1st; you may update your application after that by emailing the department chair when you hear if you are accepted into a Study Abroad program. Upon return from your trip, all Steiner scholarship recipients are expected to visit an American Studies class to report on your experience, write a thank-you note for the Steiner scholarship webpage, or otherwise help encourage others to participate in this opportunity.
