The American Papers 2016-2017

The *American Papers* is the journal of the CSUF American Studies Student Association that publishes the best essays written in American Studies courses at CSUF in the past year. In other words, we publish *your* best work, and we are looking for student contributions. So take a look at your assignments from Summer 2015 to Spring 2016, choose your best research paper or essay, and submit it to the *American Papers* for consideration.

Submission Guidelines

1) The editorial board will read all submissions anonymously, so please take your name off the body of the paper. Include only the paper title and the course for which it was written on the paper itself. Be sure to remove your name from the header of the essay.

2) The *American Papers* does not accept previously published submissions.

3) Please include a separate cover sheet with:

- your name
- your email and telephone contact information for summer and fall 2016
- the title of the paper
- the course for which it was written
- the semester in which the course was taken
- the prompt for the paper (if applicable and possible)

4) Submit your paper either to the American Studies Office (UH-313), or by emailing it to AmericanPapersCSUF@gmail.com. If submitting a hard copy to the American Studies Office, please mark your submission "Professor Dustin Abnet: American Papers." If emailing a copy, you should submit the paper and cover sheet as two separate Microsoft Word files. The subject heading of the email should say "American Papers Submission."

5) The submission deadline is 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 3, 2016.

Authors will receive a letter notifying them of the Editorial Board's decision in August. Accepted essays must be revised and resubmitted in electronic format at the beginning of the fall 2015 semester. Any questions? Contact Professor Dustin Abnet, dabnet@fullerton.edu.
